Going to a new school is quite exciting! At school children learn how to read, write and count. They also learn important social and emotional skills. Children do this, among other things, during the games and exercise programme TeamUp. During TeamUp, children have fun and make new friends. They can release their energy while exercising and learn to deal with stress and feelings such as fear and anger. Little language is used, so every child can participate from their first day at school. Fun and making contact is paramount!

TeamUp takes place every week, usually in the gym or on the schoolyard if the weather is nice. The TeamUp activities are supervised by the teachers at school. They have followed a training for this from the TeamUp coach.
